Sex Establishment Licence Requirements for Display of Public Notice

Within seven days of applying for a licence a notice advertising the application must be published in a local newspaper circulating within the area of the town where the licence is applied for. It is the applicant's responsibility to publish this notice. The Council is empowered to prescribe the form of notice and accordingly requires applicants to follow the format set out within this guidance. Applicants should note that a complete copy of the newspaper in which the advertisement has been inserted should be sent to Licensing & Land Charges, Boston Borough Council, Municipal Buildings, West Street, Boston, PE21 8QR for the attention of the Principal Licensing & Land Charges Officer.

In addition to the requirement to advertise the application in a local newspaper circulating within the borough, applicants for licences in respect of premises must display a notice of the application on or near the premises in a place where it can conveniently be read by the public for 21 days beginning with the date that the application is received by the Borough Council. The responsibility for displaying the notice is the applicant's. The Council will require evidence that this requirement has been complied with. The Council is empowered to prescribe the form of notice and accordingly requires applicants to follow the format set out overleaf.

THE NOTICE MUST BE SECURELY AFFIXED ON OR NEAR THE PREMISES TO WHICH IT RELATES FOR A PERIOD OF 21 DAYS IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE
