The Boston Marathon UK 2019 takes place this Sunday, April 14, when up to 3,000 people are expected to assemble in the Market Place. There has been a record entry of runners for the full marathon, the half marathon and the 5k fun run. Runners from all over the UK, Eastern Europe, America, Canada, Hong Kong, Germany, Ireland, Switzerland and Austria will head off at 9am. The marathon has been growing in strength year on year and this entry is 30 per cent increased on last year's. With ideal weather conditions other records could fall at what has been dubbed "the UK's flattest marathon".
