

LICENSING ACT 2003

APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an application for a Premises Licence under the above-mentioned legislation has been made by **Jahir Uddin** to Boston Borough Council in respect of premises known as **Rose of Bengal** which are situated at **67/69 West Street, Boston, PE21 8QZ**

The application applied for is to permit the following licensable activities during the given times

Sale by retail of alcohol for consumption off the premises

Monday – Sunday: 11.00 hours until 02.00 hours the following day

Recorded music

Monday – Sunday: 11.00 hours until 02.00 hours the following day

Late night refreshment

Monday – Sunday: 23.00 hours until 02.00 hours the following day

Any representations by responsible authorities or other persons regarding the application must be made in writing to the Licensing Authority, Boston Borough Council at the above address by **Friday 21st June 2019**.

It is an offence, liable on summary conviction to a fine up to Level 5 (£5000) on the standard scale, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with the application.
