

## **LICENSING ACT 2003**

### **APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE**

**Monday – Sunday: 09.00 hours until 00.00 hours**

#### **Late night refreshment**

**Monday – Sunday: 23.00 hours until 00.00 hours**

Any representations by responsible authorities or other persons regarding the application must be made in writing to the Licensing Authority, Boston Borough Council at the above address by **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2019.**

It is an offence, liable on summary conviction to a fine up to Level 5 (£5000) on the standard scale, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with the application.
