

LICENSING ACT 2003

APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an application for the variation of a Premises Licence under the above-mentioned legislation has been made by **Mrs S J Trafford** to Boston Borough Council in respect of premises known as **The Green Dragon**, which are situated at **Market Place, Swineshead, Boston, PE20 3LJ**

The application applied for is to permit the following licensable activities in the newly constructed extension. The hours licensable activities are permitted are not subject to variation.

Sale by retail of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises

Sunday – Wednesday: 09.00 hours until 23.00 hours

Thursday – Saturday: 09.00 hours until 00.00 hours

24th December: 09.00 hours until 00.00 hours

31st December: From the start of permitted hours until the end of permitted hours the following day

Sundays preceding a Bank Holiday Monday: 09.00 hours until 00.00 hours

Exhibition of a film, Indoor sporting event, Performance of live music, Playing of recorded music, Performance of a dance, Anything of a similar description to live & recorded music & performance of a dance

Sunday – Wednesday: 09.00 hours until 23.00 hours

Thursday – Sunday: 09.00 hours until 00.00 hours

24th December: 09.00 hours until 00.00 hours

31st December: From the start of permitted hours until the end of permitted hours the following day

Sundays preceding a Bank Holiday Monday: 09.00 hours until 00.00 hours

The register of applications may be inspected at the offices of Licensing and Land Charges Section, Municipal Buildings, West Street, Boston, Lincolnshire, PE21 8QR, during normal office hours.

Any representations by responsible authorities or other persons regarding the application must be made in writing to the Licensing Authority, Boston Borough Council at the above address by **Wednesday 26th August 2020**.

It is an offence, liable on summary conviction to a fine up to Level 5 (£5000) on the standard scale, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with the application.
