APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE

Sunday: 10.00 hours until 00.00 hours

31st December: 10.00 hours until 03.00 hours the following day

Exhibition of a film

Friday – Sunday: 12.00 hours until 22.00 hours

Bank Holidays: 12.00 hours until 22.00 hours

Live music

Friday – Sunday: 19.00 hours until 23.00 hours

31st December: 19.00 hours until 01.00 hours the following day (indoors)

Recorded music

Monday – Sunday: 10.00 hours until 01.00 hours

31st December: 10.00 hours until 03.00 hours the following day

Performances of dance

Monday – Sunday: 10.00 hours until 23.00 hours

Late night refreshment

Monday – Sunday: 23.00 hours until 01.00 hours the following day

31st December: 23.00 hours until 03.00 hours the following day

The register of applications may be inspected at the offices of Licensing and Land Charges Section, Municipal Buildings, West Street, Boston, Lincolnshire, PE21 8QR, during normal office hours.

Any representations by responsible authorities or other persons regarding the application must be made in writing to the Licensing Authority, Boston Borough Council at the above address by **Friday 16th October 2020**.

It is an offence, liable on summary conviction to a fine up to Level 5 (£5000) on the standard scale, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with the application.
