






What do you think local councils did well during the coronavirus pandemic?
(Kept me informed about services and support via local radio)




What do you think local councils did well during the coronavirus pandemic?
(Kept me informed about services and support via local television)




What do you think local councils did well during the coronavirus pandemic?
(Kept me informed about services and support through the council's own social media and website)




What do you think local councils did well during the coronavirus pandemic?
(Reacted quickly to the changing situation)









I think they did well during the pandemic

I think politics should have been put to one side, LCC should have organised a cross-district team of people from all the districts, who had the necessary skills to make informed decisions. This can still be formed now, to deal with the possibility of a second wave and be used in the future, for anything else that affects everyone.

Made sure they communicated with all members of the community

More information. Acted quicker in seaside towns.

I don't think local councils could have done anything differently, it is national policy that should have been different. This is not a science driven issue because the science is simply not there. Covid-19 is not SARS and yet the WHO are treating it as such. The WHO has flawed management and national governments should take their own decisions. Covid-19 is not proving any more demanding than an influenza outbreak which would not have shut down the economy. New thinking is urgently required from national policy before the damage to our economy is so severe some parts of it may never recover.

i have no idea if other members of the community were helped or not - i only know my business - self employed dog trainer - is pretty much no more and lack of information and guidance from every part of govt over numbers of people in classes, where we can and can't teach or meet has contributed hugely to that. If there wer any official sources for helping interpret the guidelines they were well hidden,

Sent out written updates by post. Don't follow social media or listen to radio. My husband is self employed and didn't get any help from universal credit or hmrc etc. Too many hard working people like him fell through the cracks

Enforcing / encouragement of social distancing and other guidelines to help curb spread of covid

Identifying and supporting people who were isolating. Self isolating who live alone.

Make provision for social distancing by giving priority to pedestrians and cyclists over cars and lorries - as had been done in other towns. The cost would have been negligible but the benefits large. Make it easy to get hold of face masks; they are available in shops now but they weren't easily available in the early weeks. Make testing available to everyone locally. I know quite a few people who are convinced they have had the virus but have not been tested. I have no confidence in the statistics.

They could have contacted people directly either by email where addresses were held or by telephone where not.

Supported local small businesses. Louth has lost a lot of shops and cafes

help with council tax

Mad sure that people who had just moved weren't isolated without help no money / no food. Bungalow we moved to still have not a proper kitchen / bathroom have asbestos needing removal. Had a divorce, had to move. Just before lockdown downsized and had also been trying to get P.I.P. reinstated then moved and lockdown

Implemented pop-up cycling infrastructure to promote active transport. Not a thing seems to have been done.

local councillors should have been more visibly supporting local volunteers and groups

The parish and town councils could have been used more effectively as public facing entities perhaps, after all they are generally known and trusted in the community

Not all people have access to the internet, especially the elderly - so any information seemed to be passed by word of mouth, although Alford had a Community Hub which was great for most people, I think some of the elderly fell through the net, and some felt neglected and overlooked - not sure how that this could have been done better - more local info on the local radio would have helped - being positive and not negative.

Inform residents of smaller communities of means and access to help and assistance

I think it was a tough time for everyone. I personally think central government should have let local government decide what was best for their area. For example, Lincolnshire remained largely unaffected and yet still had to abide by rules made for people living in central London for example. This is not the same. This should have been accounted for. Our children should have been in school etc. However, not the local council's fault but the government.

Could have done some real research into it and realised it's a hoax

Get serious about fly-tipping and open the local recycling center properly and stop using COVID 19 as an excuse to reduce the service levels at the local recycling center. One contributing factor to Fly-Tipping is that not all materials are being accepted at the tip so it's no surprise that people are making their own arrangements to dispose of their waste Unlawfully! Should have communicated with Parish Councils in order to ensure the safety and well being of residents.


Like the government, pretty much everything.
